

Major Forrest Marks



Major Forrest Marks was commissioned as an Arkansas State Trooper in 1995 and initially assigned to the department's Highway Patrol Division, Troop K (Polk County). Prior to his service as an Arkansas State Trooper he was commissioned as an officer of the Hot Springs Police Department.

In 2007 Marks was promoted to the rank of sergeant and assigned as a Highway Patrol post supervisor in Troop K (Garland County). Subsequently he was promoted to the rank of lieutenant in 2013, then captain in 2014.

Major Marks has served in command duty assignments in Troop K, headquartered at Hot Springs and Troop G headquartered at Hope.

Among his credential, Major Marks is a 2012 graduate of the Criminal Justice Institute's School of Law Enforcement Supervision, a 2012 graduate of Northwestern University's School of Police Staff and Command and a 2013 graduate of the Criminal Justice Institute's Arkansas Leader, a Command College of the Federal Bureau of Investigation.
