

## Major Lindsey Williams



Major Lindsey Williams was commissioned as an Arkansas State Trooper in 1985 and initially assigned to the department's Highway Patrol Division, Troop B, Sharp County. Major Williams began his law enforcement career in 1979 as a deputy sheriff with the White County Sheriff's Office and was later a patrolman with the Searcy Police Department.

In 1999 he was promoted to the rank of sergeant and assigned as a Highway Patrol post supervisor in Troop B. Williams was promoted to the rank of lieutenant in 2004 and assigned to be the State Fire Marshal. He was promoted to the rank of captain in 2012 and major in 2015.

Among his credentials, Major Williams graduated from Harding College, now Harding University in 1979 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Management. Major Williams is a 2008 graduate of the Criminal Justice Institute's Arkansas Leader, a Command College of the Federal Bureau of Investigation. Major Williams served as a volunteer firefighter with the Searcy Fire Department for over thirty years before retiring in 2005.
