**COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES**

**JULY 12, 2012**

The Commission held a Public Hearing for proposed changes to Specification S-9. There were no comments and the Commission gave a final vote of adoption. A motion was made by Commissioner Russell and a second was made by Commissioner Greene to adopt the proposed Changes to Specification S-9. A motion was made by Commissioner Russell to accept the minutes of the last three meetings. A second was made by Commissioner Wilburn.

ITEM I: Item one was in regard to former Trooper Clayton Moss. A motion was made by Commissioner Wilburn to go forward with decertification and a second by Commissioner Jiles, with Commissioner Cook recusing. The vote was unanimous.

Item II: Item two was regarding Officer Matthew West of the Benton County Sheriff's Office who asked for decertification of West. A motion was made by Commissioner Russell and a second

was made by Commissioner Wilburn to go forward with decertification proceedings. The motion was passed unanimously.

ITEM III: Item three was in regard to former officer Donna Cooper of the Newport Police Department. The department was requesting decertification of Ms. Cooper. A motion was made by Commissioner Jiles to go forward with decertification, and was seconded by Commissioner Greene. The vote was unanimous.

Item IV: Item four was from the Fordyce Police Department who was requesting decertification of former officer Maranda Rusk. A motion by Commissioner Walraven and a second by Commissioner Greene led to a unanimous vote to go forward with decertification.

ITEM V: Item five was from the Pulaski County Sheriff's Office in regard to former officer Eric Lambert. Lambert was dismissed after an internal investigation for violation of Uniform Standards of Conduct. A motion was made by Commissioner Russell and a second was made by Commissioner Wilburn. The vote was unanimous.

ITEM VI: Former officer Randall T. Robinson was employed by the Little Rock Police Department when he was arrested by federal agents on several drug charges. A motion was made by Commissioner Green to go forward with decertification and was seconded by Commissioner Wilburn. The vote was unanimous.

ITEM VII: Mark A. Jones was arrested by federal agents on drug related charges while he was employed by the Little Rock Police Department. A motion was made by Commissioner Wilburn and seconded by Commissioner Jiles to go forward with decertification. A unanimous vote was cast.

ITEM VIII: Item nine was a vote to go forward with decertification for former officer Duane Horner of the Garland County Sheriff's office that had been charged with rape of another officer's daughter. A motion was made by Commissioner Jiles and seconded by Commissioner Russell.

Director Jones gave a report on a meeting in regard to forming a committee to establish a firearms standard for the state. He reported that the Veterans to Law Enforcement was favorably accepted and passed through the Bureau of Legislative Research. The Canine and Canine Handlers was to be discussed the next day by the Bureau of Legislative Research and the Commission will be notified of the outcome.
