Instructions:

To log on using the ACIC Advanced Authentication Token

1. Enter your User ID/CSN in the "User ID" field.
2. Enter the last 6 characters of your Social Security Number or Unique pin in the "Password" field.

Password requirements for tokens:

- a. Be a minimum of six (6) digits
- b. Have no repeating digits (i.e., 112233)
- c. Have no sequential patterns (i.e., 123456)
- d. Not be the same as the User ID.
- e. Must be all numbers

3. Press the button on the token, and enter the 6 numbers that appear in the screen on the Token immediately following the password (no spaces).
4. Press enter.

Helpful Hints:

- Although the Token is fairly sturdy, it may be damaged if it is carried in the same pocket with change, keys and other hard items.
- The Token should be kept clean and dry.
- Care should be taken to avoid accidentally pressing the button on the Token. Each time the button on the Token is pressed, a unique number is generated for the purpose of securely logging onto the ACIC system. Repeatedly pressing the button and not using the number to log onto the system can result in the token getting out of sync with the system. Should this happen, the user will not be able to log on until the Token is reset by ACIC.

Replacement of Lost or Damaged Tokens:

ACIC is providing the initial offering of Advanced Authentication Tokens to your agency free of charge. Replacements of lost or damaged Tokens is the responsibility of your agency. **The estimated cost for each Token is \$13.**
