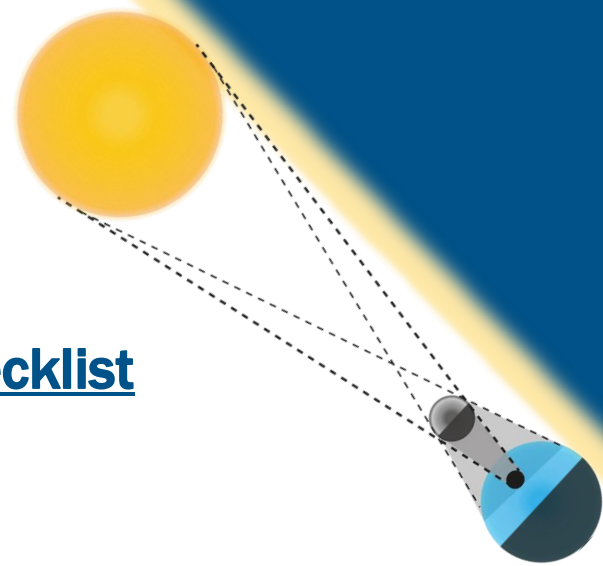


2024 Solar Eclipse Planning Checklist

COUNTY LEVEL

- Assigned Incident Command Staff for ALL Operational Periods
 - Operations
 - Police
 - Fire
 - EMS
 - Transportation
 - Public Works
 - Logistics
 - Public Safety Logistics
 - Public Logistics (e.g., portable restrooms, food services, first aid stations, etc.)
 - Planning
 - Staff Rotation Plan, Requests for supplemental staff
 - EAP Template developed for each operational period
 - Special Language Services
 - Identify needed equipment and personnel that may need to be requested
 - Public Safety Answering Point/Dispatch coordination
 - Emergency Weather Shelters and Locations
- Communications Unit Leader (COML) Assigned for Event
 - ICS Form 205's developed
 - Amateur Radio and Personnel Plan
 - Identify if there are any LTE resources needed for potential high traffic areas
- Communications Coordinator (COMC) assigned for event
- All Emergency Support Function (ESF) positions needed assigned
- Traffic management Plan developed, including Ingress and Egress Plans
- Coordination with neighboring counties for overflow and egress traffic.
- Public Information Officer and Public Information Campaign/Website for Information (social media updates)
- Air Medical Liaison
- National Weather Service Liaison
- Airport Liaison
- Special Use and Camping permits for individuals or property owners



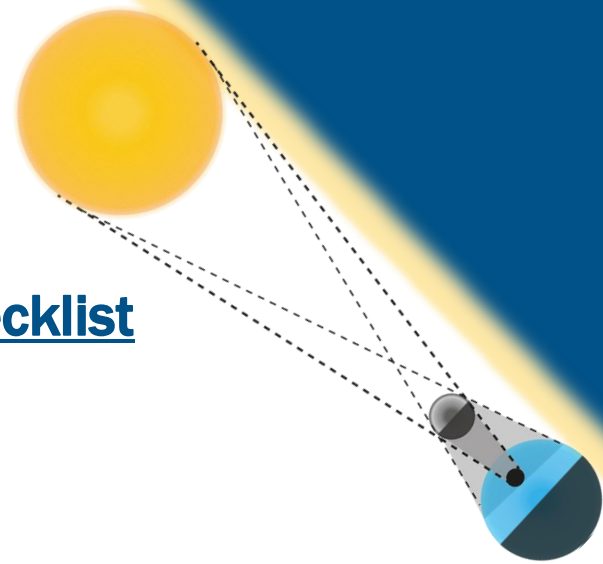

2024 Solar Eclipse Planning Checklist

REGIONAL LEVEL

- Regional Event Action Plan (EAP) developed
- Regional Communications Coordinator(s) Assigned
- Regional Traffic Plan
- Liaisons from each state identified for deconfliction purposes
- Regional Coordination Center identified (virtual options are probably best)
 - Deconfliction of resource requests
 - Federal and Emergency Mutual Aid Compact (EMAC) coordination
 - Special requests that may impact all three states
 - Vendor coordination and requests
- National Weather Service Liaison
