1021. DIRECTOR

(1) General

(a) The Director shall be a person qualified for the position, appointed by the Governor pursuant to state law.

(2) Duties

- (a) They shall perform their duties under the direction of the Commission and its committees, and their designee shall serve as Secretary to the Commission and its committees.
- (b) They shall be responsible to the Commission for conducting the Commission's daily activities, its office facilities, and general administrative tasks.

(3) Authority

- (a) They shall have authority over, and responsibility for all employees of the Division.
- (b) As the authorized representative of the Commission and subject to its ratification, they are empowered to delegate to the Deputy Director of Standards their authority to:
 - (i) Certify training schools administered by the state, county, and municipalities located within this state.
 - (ii) Certify training classes or courses within the state.
 - (iii) Revoke prior certification of a course, school, or an instructor which fails to comply with CLEST Rules. This action is subject to ratification by the Commission.
 - (iv) Certify for the Commission individual law enforcement officers pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. 12-9-106(c).
